Dear Parent/Guardian,

During the May 20 – 30, 2019 testing window, high school students completing certain end-of-course (EOC) classes will take tests to measure achievement of the Virginia Standards of Learning (SOL). Students are required to take the EOC test for a course if the test is needed for a verified credit towards a diploma. Students are also required to participate in one EOC math, one EOC reading, the EOC writing, and EOC biology SOL tests while in high school as required by the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). Participation in SOL testing has been discussed with your child. If you have questions about your child’s participation in SOL testing, please contact his or her counselor.

It is the intent of the Commonwealth of Virginia that all students, including students with disabilities, participate in SOL testing for any grade level and/or subject area for which they are receiving instruction and as required and described above. If your child has an Individual Education Plan (IEP) or Section 504 Plan, it may be necessary to meet with school personnel to confirm or document how your child will participate in the testing program.

All EOC tests will be administered online. If your child has not previously participated in online testing, your child should complete online training to become familiar with online testing procedures and tools. Online practice is available from any computer that has access to the Internet. If you wish to view test items, please visit our school website and follow the **STUDENTS, STUDENT RESOURCES** links for SOL testing.

While in the testing room, students may not have access to cell phones or other electronic devices while any students are testing. **As a 1:1 school, it is expected that your child will bring their computer/Chromebook to school on all testing days. The computer/Chromebook should be in good working order and fully charged each day.**

Your child’s official test results will be sent to you in the fall. As with any test, your child needs your support and encouragement on a daily basis. Since the assessments are designed to measure the Virginia SOL, daily instruction is the best method of preparation for the tests.
