The time has come for our annual Bayside High School Leadership Workshop. The dates for this workshop will be **Saturday, March 2nd-Sunday, March 3rd, 2019**. This is an **overnight workshop**, which will be held at Airfield 4-H Camp in Wakefield, Virginia. This is a first come, first serve application process and spaces are limited, so please return your application and monies as soon as possible. The cost for your student to attend this workshop is \$92.00, which will include transportation to and from Bayside High School to Wakefield, Virginia, all meals and snacks, a t-shirt, camp materials and overnight lodging. ***Students will be monitored by adult VBCPS chaperones at all times during this workshop and a security guard will monitor the camp grounds at all times.*** On the attached application, please provide the following information for your child: emergency contact information, medications needed/taken and allergies information. Students will have to follow all standard VBCPS rules and regulations on this trip as they would in school. ***The purpose of this workshop is to educate students on the importance of leadership both in their school and in their lives.*** Leadership is a trait that many colleges and future careers look for in individuals when deciding their acceptance. If your student is not involved in school, this would be an excellent step to meet and engage others. Only students from grades 9 through 11 are invited to attend leadership workshop. Additionally, students are required to spend the entire duration at Wakefield, Virginia and are not allowed to leave early except for emergency. Our sole transportation will be school buses, so there will be no possibility to bring a student home early, so if there is an emergency, parents must come to Wakefield, Virginia to pick up their child.
