The Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) will be administered at Bayside High School on **Wednesday, March 6, 2019 at 7:20 AM**. Your son/daughter is interested in taking this important test as a college/career planning tool. The ASVAB is a paper and pencil test provided by the Armed Services at no cost to students. It provides academic and occupational scores that indicate the student's potential for further formal education or training in selected career fields. It is an excellent practice tool for the SAT and ACT tests. The academic components include: Verbal Skills, Math Skills, and Science and Technical Skills. The occupational components are: Mechanical and Crafts, Business and Clerical, Electronics and Electrical, Health, Social, and Technology. Results provide important information for choosing a college major or career path. Even though the ASVAB is offered by the Armed Services, **no military obligation is involved in taking this test**. Students are encouraged to go to [march2success](http://march2success.com) for practice questions.

Students must report to the BHS Auditorium by **7:15 a.m. on Wednesday, March 6th**. The test lasts approximately 3 hours. Students must be 16 years old by February 6, 2019 to take the test.
